I invite your immediate attention to the subject and reference cited In the reference cited, the Government of India have issued certain guidelines for deductions and deposits of TDS by the DDO under GST. As per the GSTAct, all DDOs have to deduct the 18% GST TDS amount on the invoices generated in APCOS portal for the payments made to the Outsourced employees through CFMSpo1aI and the software of CFMS is designed in a such a way that 2º/o GST TDS will bedeposited in DDO's current account and 16% GST TDS will be deposited in APCOS current bank account.

Further, the DDO's have to follow certain procedures in CFMS as well as in GST portal for depositing 2% GST TDS in APCOS current bank account.

But, it is observed that most of the DDO's are not following the procedure and thereby the APCOS is facing much difficulty in remitting18% GST TDS to Govt.

Therefore, all DDO's are requested to obtain GST Identification Number and file GST returns in their GST login against the APCOS GSTIN as it is their statutoryresponsibility to file returns in form GSTR-7. A copy of the guidelines issued by the Govt of India is appended to this letter for ready reference of all DDO's and with a request to take immediate action otherwise penalities will be levied by Tax authoritiesagainstdefaultDDO's.
